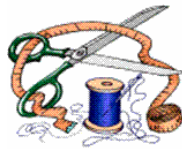

Sewing Kits

- 3 continuous yards of fabric – cotton or cotton blend only
- 1 pair fabric scissors
- 1 package of hand needles
- 1 medium or large spool of thread (no travel kit thread)
- 5 – 8 buttons
- 1 one gallon size sealable plastic bag

Health Kits

- 1 hand towel (15"x25" to 17" x 27")
- 1 wash cloth
- 1 comb
- 1 metal nail file or clipper (no emery boards)
- 1 3oz. or larger bath soap in original packaging
- 1 adult toothbrush in original packaging
- 6 band aids
- 1 one gallon size sealable plastic bag
- \$1.00 to purchase toothpaste

School Kits

- 1 pair of blunt scissors (rounded tip only, not plastic scissors)
- 3 units of paper (no composition books) 8½ x 11 spiral notebooks or top-bound pads **or** 150 sheets of loose leaf **or** combinations of spiral, top bound or loose leaf
- 1 hand held pencil sharpener
- 1 30 cm ruler (hard or flexible)
- 6 unsharpened pencils
- 1-1½ inch eraser
- 1-24 count of crayons
- 1 – 14 x 16 inch cloth bag— Home made or purchased heavy fabric only – denim, corduroy, drapery fabric
